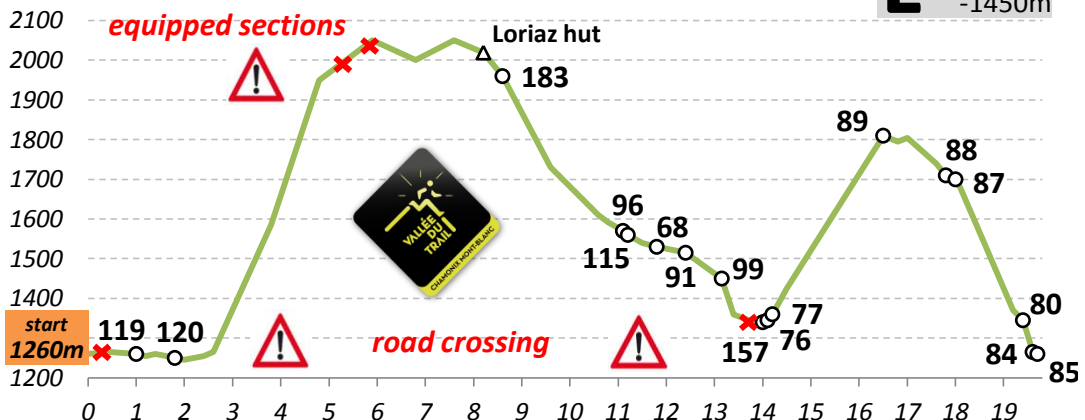


Circuit Vallorcine-Passet pass-aiguillettes Parées

Duration estimated depending on speed : 3 hr ¼ to 6 hrs ½

Circuit Vallorcine-Passet pass-aiguillettes Parées, 19.8Km, +1450m/-1450m
Vallorcine train station, take the bridge opposite the station then follow the road to the right for 200m to the Office de Tourisme. Follow the road sign for « le Mollard » as far as signpost 119.

Signpost n° ► direction or instruction from this signpost
119 ► Chemin des Diligences
120 ► Col du Passet / Emosson, follow as far as the Passet pass at 1950m (alt.).
Col du Passet ► Loriaz
Loriaz hut ► Vallorcine, then 200m lower down at the crossing, go left off the 4x4 track.
183 ► Les Granges
 At 1600m (alt.), descend the **4x4 track** for 350m and don't miss the signpost 96 on the right.
96 ► Très les Eaux, stay on the path through the middle of the chalets - do not descend.
115 ► Sur le Rocher

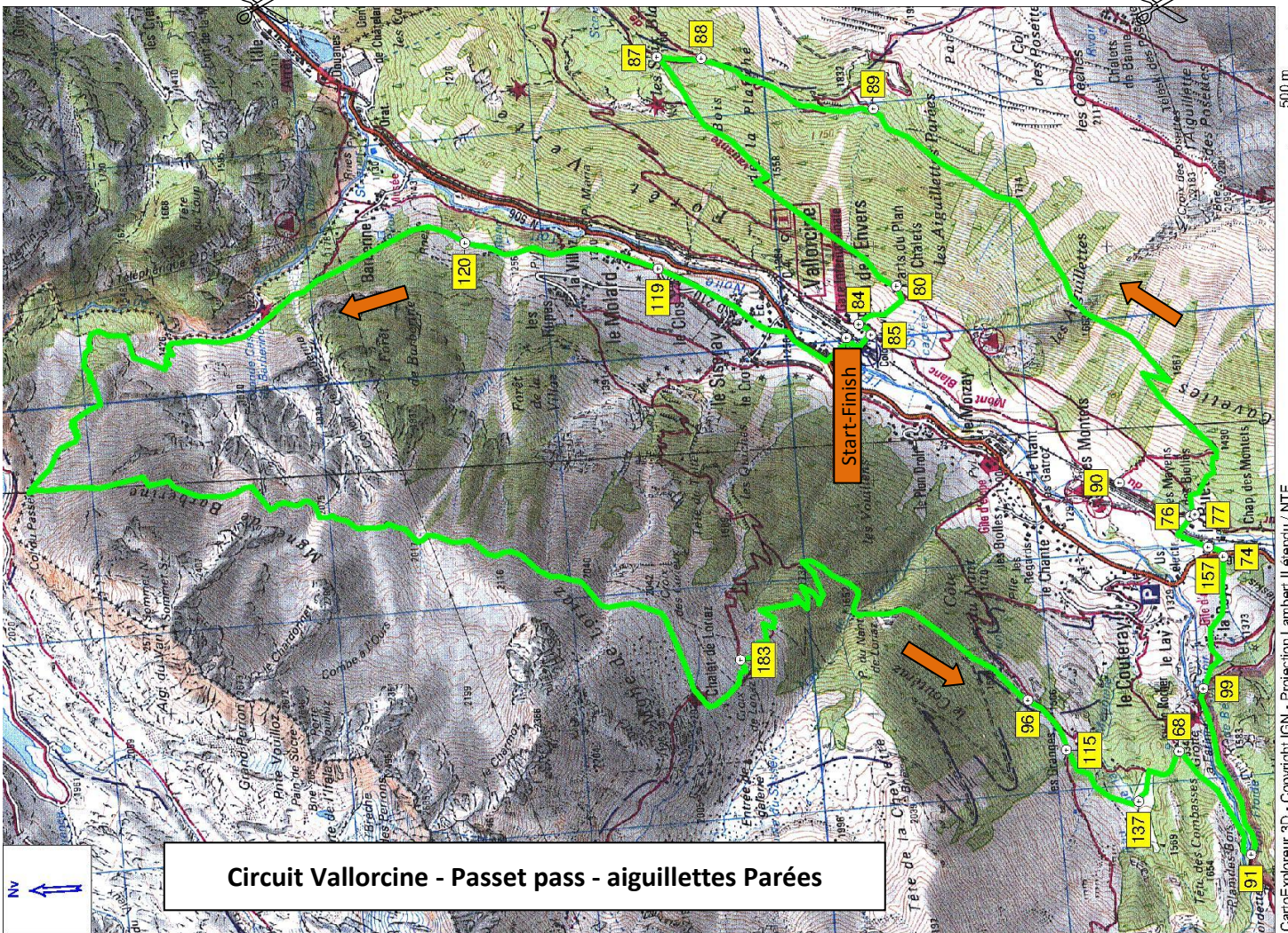
68 ► Bérard
91 ► Cascade de Bérard
99 ► Le Buet
74 ► Cross the road and the car park for signpost 157 on the left.
157 ► Col des Posettes
76 ► Col des Montets
77 ► Col des Posettes
89 ► Vallorcine
88 et 87 ► Les Parts
80 ► Vallorcine Village
84 ► Le Buet
85 ► Vallorcine Village

A circuit which covers both sides of the valley. This loop is ideal for « long » training, with principal difficulties comprising two good climbs and several sections equipped with chains and hand-rails higher up.

Although from Vallorcine station the route begins gently enough, with 2km of road and footpath on a virtually flat terrain, from the Barberine waterfall (which can be visited with a return trip) there is a steep ascent until the Col du Passet. From the pass, at 1950m of altitude, a technical traverse on the first section takes the route across to the alpine meadows of La Loriaz. The more rolling second section finally allows contemplation of the panorama of the Mont Blanc massif. After the Loriaz hut, the hanging path finishes and descends via some hamlets typical of Vallorcine and the Bérard valley. At the level crossing at Le Buet station, the second ascent begins, into a beautiful forest of larch trees. The route then finishes with a descent into the valley once more on a good, quick, and sometimes technical, footpath.
